Dear Year 6 parents and carers,

**Re. Year 6 leaver's activities**

**Production**

This term, Year 6 will be taking part in a production called 'Star Warts'. The performances to family will take place on **Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July (6-7.30 pm)** and **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> July (5-6.30 pm)**, as well as a rehearsal to the school during the day of Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup>. Information regarding costumes was shared at the end of Term 5. Please can all costumes be brought to school in a labelled bag by Thursday 10th July. These will be stored in school and the children will get changed before each performance.

**Graduation**

Year 6 graduation will be held at St. Saviour's Church on **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July starting at 2pm, although the church will be open from 1pm**. Children will need to wear school uniform for the graduation. During the service, parents and family are encouraged to attend and there will be ample opportunities for photos on the day. Each child will be presented with a certificate and leavers photo to keep. The End of Year Cups will also be presented. Younger siblings will be brought to the church and, once the service is finished, you will be free to take your children home. Please make sure that your child's class teacher knows before you leave. Any children not collected will be brought back to school and dismissed at the end of the school day as usual.

**Barbecue**

As usual, we will hold the leavers' barbecue on the school field. The event is from 2pm until 4pm on **Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July** and is for Year 6 children only. We will provide food, drink and entertainment. You will simply need to collect your child (filled with sugar, no doubt) at 4pm from the school field, or they can walk home as usual. A letter to inform us of going home arrangements will follow.

Children should come to school in their school uniform (due to the end of term church service at 9.30 am) and bring a set of comfortable clothes to change into after lunch (or they can wear their leavers' t-shirts – see below). We will be on the school field all afternoon so please ensure children have suitable clothing, sun cream, sunhats and water bottles with them.

**T-shirt day**

As a parting gift, the children will receive leavers' t-shirts. On **Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July**, they will be handed out in school and the children can wear their leavers' t-shirts in school should they wish to. A reminder that our end of term service will be held at St. Saviour's church on **Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July at 9:30am**. All parents are welcome to attend.

**Final day**

On the final day of term, Year 6 children will have the opportunity to have their shirts signed by their peers and may bring in felt tip pens/sharpiers. Shirt signing will take place on **Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July during the afternoon** – children will not be permitted to sign shirts before Tuesday afternoon. We will remind children in school, but rude or inappropriate language and/or drawings will not be tolerated and anyone behaving inappropriately will miss out on shirt signing.
