St. Saviour's fosters a strong sense of community and belonging. Community, Consideration, Courage

Our vision and values are at the core of everything we do. They underpin our teaching and learning, and provide an environment which prepares our pupils as confident, happy citizens.

How is this policy a reflection of our vision and values?

This policy formalises the moral obligation we have to inclusively serve our community by admitting vulnerable children. We will give consideration and care to all who apply, taking into account the needs of individuals and families.

The number of children who will be admitted in this admission cohort is 96 pupils with a maximum of 32 children per class.

Places will be offered in accordance with the following criteria:

1. Looked after children and children previously in care.
2. Pupils who attend St. Crispin's Infant School.
3. Where at the time of entry there is a current family association with a child attending the school who lives as brother/and or sister of the child who is subject of an application in the same household.
4. Health and special access reasons.
5. Proximity to the school.

Oversubscription

Where applications for admission exceed the number of places available the criteria above will be applied. The Governing Body will meet to consider cases where appropriate.
