Dear Parents and Carers,

For sports day this year, we are aiming to have the whole school together competing in teams and celebrating each other's successes. In order for us to do this successfully, we are going to be holding sports day in the morning as there is more time available than in the afternoon. Sports Day will be held on Friday 26th June between 9.15am and 12.15pm.

The outline for the day

The field will be accessible to you from 9.00am. At 9.15am, the children will all compete in their teams, within their classes, on a range of relay-type activities. Year 3/4 pupils will be on the circuit at the bottom half of the field (nearest the school building) whilst Year 5/6 pupils will be on the circuit on the top half of the field. The 6 activities will take about an hour to complete. These will be followed by a 30-minute drinks break in which pupils will get drinks, use the toilets and staff can have a break too. Parents are welcome to stay and there will be drinks on sale throughout the morning at the Pavilion. At 10.45am, everyone will move onto the races on the track. There will be two tracks set up on the field, so Year 3/4 will run together and Year 5/6 will also run together. All pupils will compete in a couple of running events each and we will do our best not to have siblings running at the same time. At the end of the morning (about 12:00) there will be a presentation for the winning team.

Parents are welcome support during all the events and the running races throughout the morning as there will be viewing areas around the edge and through the middle of the field marked out. If we have any lovely parents out there who would be willing to help run the refreshments stall during the morning, please let the school office know. Please note, these refreshments are for those of you who are coming to watch the events – not for the children taking part. The pupils will be given a break time to have their morning snack

Please ensure your child knows what team they are in and arrives in school wearing their school PE kit and a coloured top that represents their team. Please see below for team colours. It would also be favourable for children to ensure they bring a water bottle, sun hat and sun cream to school as we are hopeful the weather will be sunny.
